### **History Essay Competition**

### **Exploring Law Conference 2024 - CSFL**





The Exploring Law Conference gives Year 12 students who may be interested in studying Law at degree level a balanced view of Law, both as an academic subject and as a profession, and also to offer an **insight into life as a Cambridge undergraduate**.

The Conference is run by a voluntary committee of 7 current law undergraduates and relies on the support of the University of Cambridge's Law Faculty.

The 2024 Conference will be a 4 day in-person Conference. The committee are working hard to bring as many students as possible into Cambridge for a residential experience which will aim to offer students a taste of the study of Law. The conference will run between Monday 25th March and Thursday 28th March.

This year the conference will cost £155. There are additionally 150 fully funded places for qualifying students.

## University of Cambridge Research Opportunity- The DEBAT Study

- We are emailing on behalf of the University of Cambridge's Diet and Eating Behaviours across Early Adulthood Transition (DEBEAT) study, which commenced in September 2023. We are looking to recruit final-year students aged 17-18 from schools and colleges across England to participate. This is an opportunity for students to participate in a university research study and learn more about healthy diets and eating behaviours.
- Eligible participants will be asked to complete seven short online questionnaires over 14 days through our two online systems, REDCap and Intake24, about their diet, behaviours and environments. Interested participants will first be directed to our webpage to ensure their understanding of the study and asked to complete a consent form. Once consented, participants will be asked to complete seven short (10-15 min) questionnaires over the next 14 days, all of which can be completed in their own time with no school involvement. Participants will also be asked to complete the same questionnaires 12 months later.
- We will share with the participating students all the research findings from the study in formats appropriate for this audience (e.g. online presentation, magazine article, animated video) and information on what we are doing with these findings. We will keep in touch throughout the study, allowing the students an insight into the research process. We will also offer these participants personalised feedback on their own diet in relation to the other participants in the study so they can understand how their diet might be influencing their health.
- We will compensate the participating students for their time with up to £50 in Amazon vouchers if they complete all seven web-based questionnaires across the two time points.
