Girls Go Circular

Digital and Entrepreneurial Skills for the Circular Economy

In three years, the Girls Go Circular initiative equipped +40,000 schoolgirls aged 14–19 across Europe with digital and entrepreneurial skills through an online learning programme about the circular economy.

The platform includes several modules, which explore the circular economy from different angles. While consolidating their knowledge on the green transition, students use digital tools to acquire practical skills. After successfully completing a learning module, students receive a certificate that attests the skills acquired.

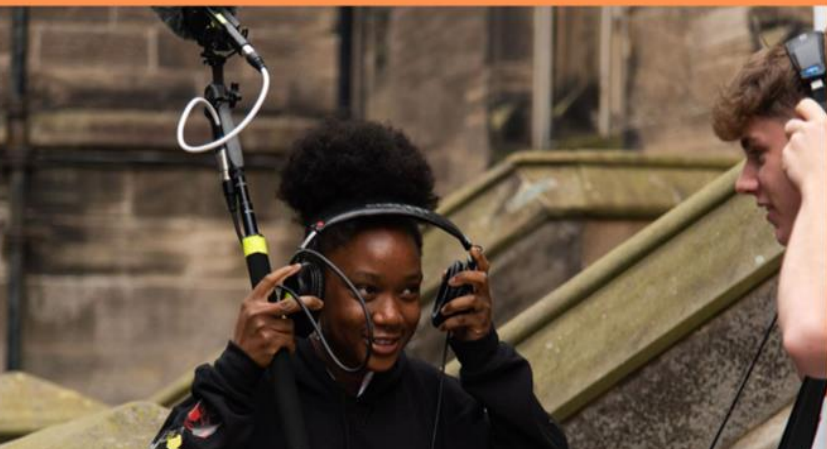

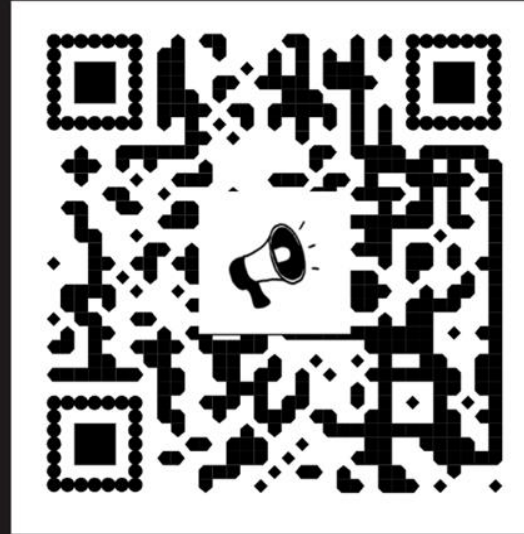


Volunteer with The Enfield Talking Newspaper

You will take part in activities that provide insight into the medical profession, support your medical school application and prepare you for starting university.



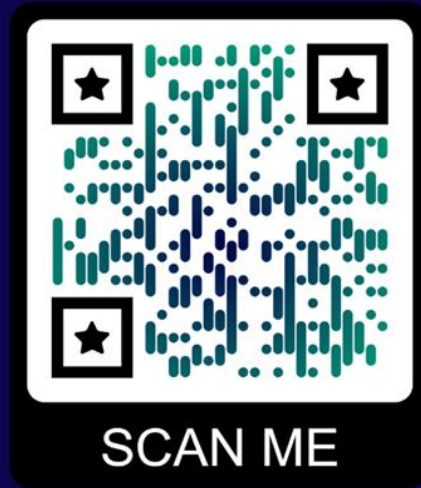
